

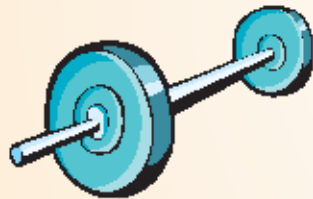
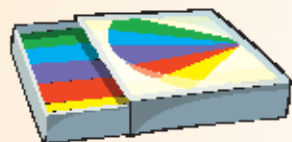
# I am a Hero... I am a Heroine!

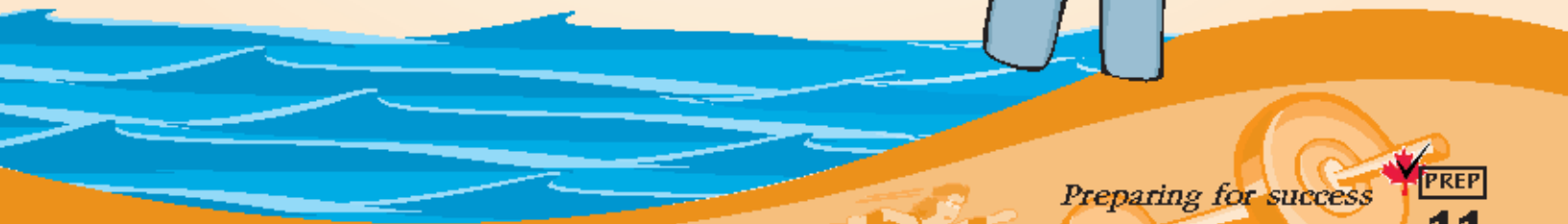
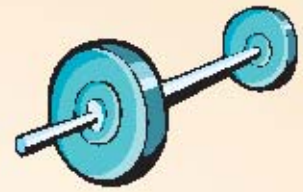

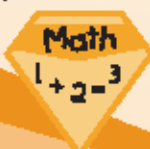
